Attached is the flyer and zoom attendance of the membership seminar.




## DISTRICT GOVERNOR'S VISIT/COMMISSIONING OF STAR PROJECTS:

**INVESTITURE:**



Based on our participation in the Basic Education and Literacy Projects in September our club was given yet another certificate


of recognition by the district for our outstanding role in the project execution amongst other clubs within the district MULTI-CLUB SEMINAR:



**FIRST BABY OF THE YEAR PROJECT  
JANUARY – 2022  
AND VOCATIONAL SERVICE AWARD**

The Rotary theme for this month of JANUARY is Vocational Service Month. The execution of our flagship project tagged "First Baby of the Year Project" AND "Awards of Excellence to Best Junior and Best Senior Staffs of Lagos Island Maternity" which is a vocational service award, in line with the theme for the month of January. Rotary Club of Lagos Central carried out the above-named projects on the 1st of January, 2022 at Lagos Island maternity by 8am yearly. Our club have embarked on the First Baby of the year project for the past 40 years. As part of efforts aimed at putting smiles on the faces of families, Rotary Club of Lagos Central honoured the first baby of the year at Lagos Island Maternity Hospital. The baby, a male was delivered of at 12:10am January 1st 2022 to the family of Mr. and Mrs. Qudus Layembi. He weighed 5kg. Baby clothes, baby cot, mosquito net, cash presentation were among the gifts given to the mother of the baby. MTN shares was also bought for the baby. The second and third babies were equally honoured.

President of the Club, Rtn. Rotimi Okafor Esq.(PHF) said the first baby of the year is the club's flagship project which began over forty years ago. In his words, "every January 1st, we felicitate with the first baby of the year. Service to humanity is the watchword of the club and we always put smiles on the faces of the needy. In the past years, there have been clamour by the management of the hospital to give the second and third babies gifts and we saw that as "Oliver Twist". Since the Directors and Board approved of this and "we deem it fit to give gifts to the second and third babies this year. We also use this occasion to commend the health officials, who are the front-line workers in the fight against COVID-19."

Expressing his appreciation, the Chief Medical Director, Lagos Island Maternity, Dr. Olufemi Omololu said, "it is a thing of joy and it is something we do every year at Island Maternity. 

## STAR PROJECTS

The club has embarked on our STAR PROJECT; Elegbaata Senior High School project. We have three major areas to deliver upon as we have identified: 1. Construction of roof and new ceilings in classrooms and staff rooms. 2. Provision of water via purchase of a brand new pumping machine for the borehole. 3. Painting of the internal and external walls of the school building. The club needs a total of N2.5 Million Naira to complete the project. The district grant received by the club in January/February 2022 is N300,000 and the club set its own fund of N450,000 as counterpart or matching grant. This gave us a total of N750,000 in our project account to which we have raised #1,750,000 by club members.

## VOCATIONAL TRAINING /ECONOMIC COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT OF INDIGENT YOUTHS (GBEMISOKE)

The Club embarked on vocational training to economically empower the community youths within Lagos-Island. This ran from 25th to 29th of April, 2022. Youths were trained for Baking, Makeup and Gele, Shoe Making, Tailoring and Barbing. They were also supported with little cash to aid them set up. Rtn Dr. Olatutu Sholeye was the project coordinator with an excellent delivery.

## PROJECT SAVE MY SISTER

This is donation of 200 menstrual cups to Girls in Lagos Island, to eliminate 300,000 pads which would have been evacuated by LAWMA to landfill and achieve a cost savings of 2.4 million naira for the recipients.

Donations are still being received for the execution before May ending.
